

Service and Installation Rules

Course outline

Learners completing this training will understand how to interpret the Service and Installation Rules specific to Evoenergy, identify a network boundary, understand what work can be undertaken and identify when an installation can and cannot be energised or de-energised.

Validity

Evoenergy requires training and re-assessment every 12 months.

Entry requirements and prerequisites

Learners must:

- be an employee of a company accredited with Evoenergy, and
- have current validity for the Evoenergy Electrical Safety Rules course, and
- have a current unrestricted ACT Electrical Licence loaded to their Beakon profile.

Resources

Learners will require access to:

- a stable internet connection, and
- a device that has audio functionality (tablet, laptop, or desktop PC), and
- an electronic or printed copy of Evoenergy's Service and Installation Rules.

Fees

\$200.pp (GST inclusive)

The courses offered by Evoenergy attract fees and are invoiced directly to the Learners employer post course completion. Invoices have strict payment terms of 30 days and are payable by credit card, direct deposit or cheque.

An outstanding payment of these fees may result in the temporary suspension of company accreditation and/or the workers authorisation.

Enrolment

This course must be completed by any licensed electrician in the ACT who is:

- required to install and/or remove service fuses at the network boundary for single premises, and/or
- required to terminate consumer mains cables at the network boundary of single premise installations (not including Point of Attachment style network boundaries), and/or
- applying for an Evoenergy key to access metering or isolation locations in multi tenanted installations.

Through Beakon, Evoenergy's Service and Installation Rules course is available as eLearning - allowing Learners to complete the course at a time that best suits their schedule and can be completed as initial or refresher training.

To access the eLearning, Learners must be enrolled into one of the monthly sessions. These can be viewed and enrolled for using the Learning Sessions module in Beakon.

Once enrolled, the eLearning can be accessed anytime during that monthly session period.
